Guidelines for Individuals Applying for Assistance

It can be hard to ask for help especially when feeling overwhelmed, stressed, and worried about money. We provide hardship grants for a variety of reasons.

Who can apply

To be eligible for a grant from Junius you must be a current, former or retired registered nurse, midwife or nursing associate who has practiced for a minimum of five years post registration within the UK.

You must be, or have been, registered with the NMC.

Unfortunately, we cannot accept applications from individuals living outside of the UK, healthcare assistants, carers or student nurses.

If you have more than £4,000 in household savings including money in savings and current accounts we will be unable to provide financial assistance.

Our hardship grants can help with

- Short term financial emergencies
- Essential white goods
- Travelling expenses for attending medical treatment
- Mobility aids
- Home adaptations due to disability
- Rent deposits and removal costs

We are unable to help with

- Educational costs
- Funeral costs
- Respite care fees
- Nursing home fees
- Holidays

Supporting Documentation

All applicants must attach the following supporting documents with their application form:

- **Bank Statements:** The last two full months of bank statements for all accounts that you hold. These need to show

- Name
 - Address
 - Full account number
 - Sort code
 - Transactions
 - Running balance
- **Proof of professional eligibility:** If you are no longer on the NMC register you will need to provide evidence of employment such as a copy wage slip, employment contract or email/letter from a employer/former employer.
 - **Supporting Evidence:** One of the following options of further information must be provided to support your application such as:
 - Evidence of medical condition
 - Statement of arrears in rent, council tax, utility bills
 - Quote for any required services
 - A letter of support from an independent professional. This could be a GP, Health Visitor, Social Worker, Citizens Advice Bureau, Housing Agency, Charity or any other person acting in a professional capacity. The letter cannot be from a friend or work colleague.

We cannot process an application until we have received all the documents outlined in the section above. If the documentation is not provided as requested, this will delay your application. All applicants will be given a two-week deadline to provide any outstanding supporting documents. If the additional documents are not provided by the deadline, the application will be closed.

Once an application and supporting documentation has been reviewed, you may be asked to provide further information and you will be contacted via email to provide this.

Applicants are not guaranteed assistance as all applications are judged on a case-by-case basis. Applicants will be notified as soon as possible after the Trustee decision has been made.

Please note, if you have applied within the last 12 months, you are not eligible to re-apply during this time.
